AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST BRADFORD, COUNTY. PENNSYLVANIA, THE **AMENDING** OFFICIAL MAP EAST OF BRADFORD TOWNSHIP **PURSUANT** TO ARTICLE IV OF PENNSYLVANIA **MUNICIPALITIES PLANNING** CODE AND AMENDING CHAPTER 19, OFFICIAL MAP, OF THE EAST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP CODE.

AND NOW this 9th day of March 2010, the Board of Supervisors of East Bradford Township hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

Section 1. § 19-1, "Adoption of map", is hereby amended to read as follows: The plan attached and appended hereto titled "Official Map", prepared by East Bradford Township, dated January 13, 2010, consisting of one sheet, is hereby adopted as the Official Map of East Bradford Township in accordance with Article IV of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (MPC).

Section 2. § 19-2, "Contents", is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Official Map of East Bradford Township depicts by mapping and textual notes existing and proposed public streets; watercourses and public grounds; existing and proposed public parks, playgrounds and open space reservations; existing and proposed pedestrian sidewalks, trails, bicycle routes and easements.

Section 3. § 19-3, "Time limit for reservations for future takings or acquisitions", is hereby amended to read as follows:

The time limitation referred to in Section 406 of the MPC (53 P.S. §10406) on reservations for future takings or acquisitions for public use shall be in effect until December 31, 2015.

Section 4. If a section, subsection, sentence, clause or any part of the Official Map of East Bradford Township or this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days from the date of enactment.
