- Updates on the Bishop Tube site:

 - Remedial investigation (RI) activities continue at the site (Progress Reports #120 and #121) with additional collections of groundwater, surface water, and soil samples.
 - EAC members would like to request that DEP, Roux, and PRPs attend an upcoming EAC meeting to provide us an update on the status of the RI.
- Update on the Malvern TCE site:
 - The PRP has agreed to broaden the soil/groundwater investigation at the former disposal area (FDA). A proposal, that would involve sonic drilling into bedrock in order to better define the vertical extent of soil and groundwater contamination, is under review.
